From the desk of Rev. Nancy Werner (Council President)

Last month a change occurred with the leadership of the Hanover Area Council of Churches. The Executive Committee of HACC has accepted a letter of resignation from Carol Hinkle, the Executive Director, effective April 21st. We give thanks for her many years of service and dedication to our organization and its many ministries. During her years of leadership, the ministries have evolved and grown.

We look forward to continuing in that path, meeting the needs of the greater Hanover Area in the years ahead. As we move forward, we will be forming a task force to take steps in the search for our new Executive Director. The Executive Committee has appointed our current Associate Executive Director, Mirna Wildasin, as interim Executive Director, until the search is completed.

During this transition we are confident in Mirna's skills and experience to lead our staff and volunteers to maintain the level of services on which our community members depend, and our partners and our donors have come to expect. Mirna is a graduate of Hanover High School and very familiar with our community, both its needs and its assets. She has an Associates Degree and a wealth of experience leading social services organizations locally. She served as the Executive Director for a prevention program for at-risk youth and families in conjunction with school districts in Adams County for 20 years. She worked in partnership with the Hanover YWCA for 5 years in program leadership for reaching out to at-risk youth in Hanover and Spring Grove. The Hispanic American Center of Hanover, with Mirna as its Executive Director, entered a partnership with HACC in 2015. This partnership evolved and eventually she was invited to join the staff of HACC. In April 2020 Mirna accepted the position of Associate Executive Director. In this role her work was and continues to be very important to day-to-day operations of the ministries during the COVID-19 pandemic.

We see Mirna's passion for making our community a better place to live for everyone is evidenced by her organizing Kid's Day for 10 years and the Diversity Summit for 12 years. We thank Mirna for stepping into the position of interim Executive Director during this time of transition!

The Changing Lives Shelter remains on a limited capacity, with the following guidelines in place:

- 1. The Shelter office operates 22-hours a day, 7-days a week. The Shelter closes each day between 11am and 1pm. Potential residents must have lived in the Greater Hanover Area for at least four to six months;
- 2. The Shelter is operating on a one-person per room basis, due to Covid-19. The Shelter has the capacity to hold six men, six woman and two families.
- 3. Residents are subjected to mandatory random drug and alcohol testing. The Shelter has implemented the temperature monitoring system to safeguard our Residents and Staff.
- 4. Volunteers are currently needed in the Shelter during the afternoon/evening from 1pm-5pm and 5pm-8pm.


There is also a weekly radio broadcast on 1280 AM or 95.3 FM at 8:30 each Sunday morning.
