THE CHANGING LIVES SHELTER

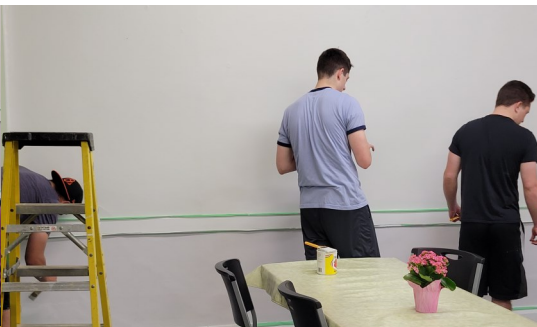
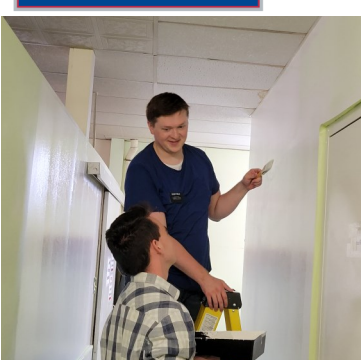

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints came in full force to assist with the painting of the lobby and main dining hall and the tidying of the clothing bank. Many hands definitely made lighter work in this case. The Color Wheel graciously donated many of the supplies needed , and paint was supplied to us by The Home Depot and Lowes. In the span of one day they were able to get most of the main areas completed. There were 30 volunteers , who gave 90 hours in total , working on this project. While we will still need to finish off the work that was started, we are grateful for the lovely job they all did. A special thanks goes out to our volunteer Grace Mullen, who was able to spearhead and coordinate this initiative through **Just Serve.org**, a service which brings communities together by helping to link the volunteer needs of organizations with volunteers to meet those needs.



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

CLOTHING BANK

Our clothing Bank is open to the public. Come and shop Monday—Thursday from 9 am to 12 pm . We have many items including: Gently used clothing (all styles and sizes. Newborns, Children, Women, and Men) Dishes, Small appliances, Home accessories and much more!

Clothing is free, although monetary donations are appreciated. Other items are priced accordingly.

Due to COVID and to keep everyone safe an appointment must be made. Appointments are made on the hour and are limited to 12 individuals (adult and children) at a time. You must wear a mask and obey social distancing rules while you shop. Stop by or call 717-633-6353 to make an appointment



CHANGING LIVES SHELTER

The Changing Lives Shelter remains on a limited capacity, with the following guidelines in place:

1. The Shelter office operates 22-hours a day, 7-days a week. The Shelter closes each day between 11am and 1pm. Potential residents must have lived in the Greater Hanover Area for at least four to six months if not they must have proof of a covid test or vaccination.
2. The Shelter is operating on a one-person per room basis, due to Covid-19. The Shelter has the capacity to hold six men, six woman and two families.
3. Residents are subjected to mandatory random drug and alcohol testing. The Shelter has implemented the temperature monitoring system to safeguard our Residents and Staff.
4. Volunteers are currently needed in the Shelter one day a week from 7 AM to 11 AM.

PROVIDE A LUNCH

Lunch is served daily from 11:30 AM—12:30 PM. It is still on a carryout basis. You may come to the back entrance during those times to pick up a bagged lunch. The dining hall is still not open to the public.

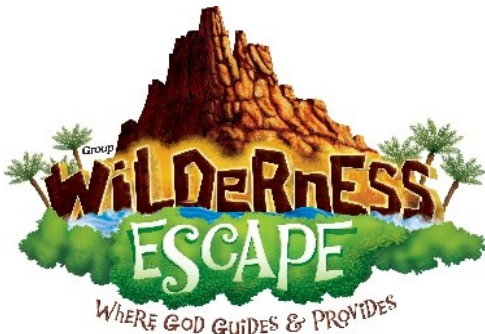

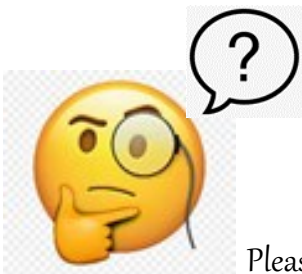
