We are delighted to announce the return of our former Clothing Bank Coordinator, Sylvia Green after a two-year absence, ran the Clothing Bank for 18 years! Sylvia, along with her sister Dawn Graf, re-joined us on Tuesday, January 27^{th} . Sylvia will resume as the Clothing Bank Coordinator and Dawn as her assistant. The clothing bank will be closed for restructuring from January 31^{st} until February 14^{th} , 2022 for a gran reopening on February 15th, 2022. With a warm heart, we welcome back these two beautiful ladies to HACC.

"If it wasn't for HACC, I wouldn't be here today!" Michael Butera

His life has been shaped by "the system." In his 33 years, he's been homeless, institutionalized, abused, neglected, addicted, incarcerated, and suicidal. He's also found love, lost love, buried both his parents, has 3 kids, and technically died 3 times. But he is still alive today, resilient and inspired as ever to make a change in this dark, troubled, and lonely world. At 13, he began a series of stints at various youth development centers in the York, PA area. At age



15, he was finally going to public school, getting good grades, joining the football team, and applying for his first after school job at McDonalds. As fate would have it, he was biking home from a friends' house after swimming one day, and he got hit by a jeep Cherokee. He woke up 2 weeks later with no recollection of what happened. He had 9 fractured bones, nerve damage in his foot, brain damage, and two titanium rods in his left leg. After being in a coma for 4 days and in and out of consciousness for a week and a half, he was finally awake but stayed in the hospital for the rest of the month. Michael went home to the "care" of his mother, who was more concerned about her addictions. Eventually they were evicted and found themselves at the Hanover Area Council of Churches' cold weather shelter in 2003 and 2014, where Michael found peace and the proper assistance to survive. He has said, "I wouldn't be here today if HACC's shelter would of never taking me in. This place saved my life". Michael turned his life around and now he has 3 songs on Spotify and pandora with followers in 60 countries (interestingly he is most popular in Russia!). He is dedicated to making music that touches peoples' hearts and making sure the oppressed have a voice. He currently lives in Hanover, Pennsylvania with his best friend and love, and their 3 kids. In some of Michael's presentations in Hanover, he has dedicated himself in providing 10% of all proceeds to be donated to the Hanover Area Council of Churches, "It is a way of giving back to HACC", His next performance will be on Saturday, February 19th at 7:30 PM at The Blackrose Ballroom, 34 Broadway rear entrance, Hanover, PA 17331.
