## Reflections From A Clothing Bank Volunteer by Kathye Maus

Somewhere in the late 1990's, as I felt in my heart the desire to help those in need, I pursued volunteering at the Hanover Area Council of Church's clothing bank. I was put in the position to take over the "specials room," also called "the closet", which consisted of jeans, socks, and underwear for school age children and whatever other donations may come in that they felt I could distribute. At that time we began to purchase new jeans and seek to find whatever stores would offer us a discount! Over these last 25 years that room has developed into quite a distribution area! Not only do we carry things that are donated, we have a budget to purchase things which we are in need of.

Many churches do "Undie Sundays" to donate children's underwear and socks. They also do glove trees to donate hats, scarves, and gloves. We distribute blankets, sheets, towels, baby items including diapers and wipes, toiletries, new jeans for school-aged children, new underwear and new socks for all ages, school supplies and whatever else someone may donate that others can use. The specials room is only open on Tuesday mornings and those that would like supplies from there must qualify as low income. We do keep track of what each client receives as these items are dispersed on a limited basis. You may, on occasion, see me in a store clearing off a clearance rack of jeans, underwear and socks! I'm always looking for the best bargain!

I love that we can help people get through difficult seasons of their lives and it really blesses me when I run into someone after having not seen them for several months and find out that they are doing well...working a job and living life. That's what this ministry is all about- blessing and serving others, meeting needs and striving to brighten people's day!
