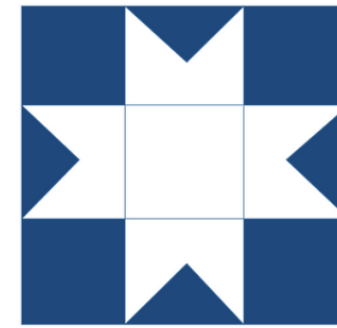

# MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT

The Provide-a-Lunch (PAL) program began in 1983 in the Hanover area and is still going strong. Not unlike our Meals-on-Wheels program, PAL has two paid staff members and a multitude of volunteers cooking and preparing a hot, nutritious lunch daily to a growing number of clients. The service is offered every day of the year, including holidays.

PAL is served from 11:30am-12:30pm, and is open to anyone who desires a hot meal. You can stay and eat in our lunchroom, or take-out containers are also available.

Our primary PAL Coordinator, Barbara Gil is responsible for making monthly menus with the PAL Teams, plus order ingredients in advance - but she also allows for donations and uses our Food Bank grants as much as possible. She has been the PAL coordinator since January 2023.

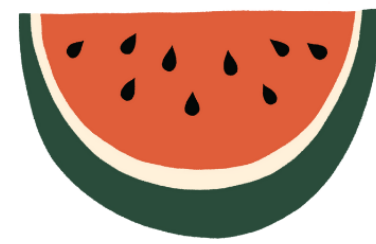
